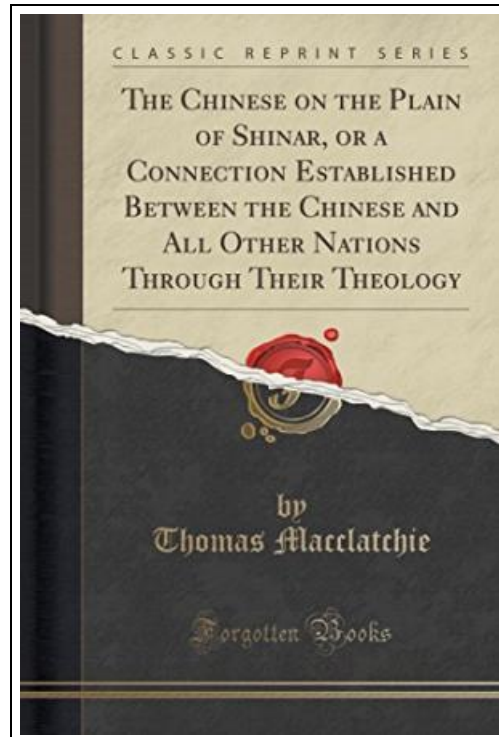

To account for this similarity is an interesting, and, at first sight, a difficult under taking. There is no doubt that this theory will, to a certain extent, account for the resemblance alluded to. For instance, no one who contemplates the sun, the dispenser of light and heat, who nourishes the earth with his genial warmth; the moon walking in brightness and the stars, which with subdued light, wander through infinite ethereal space, can fail to be struck with, and to admire the beauty of...
